

## How To Send And Receive Large Files When E-mail Won't Work

If you want to share audio, video, or large graphic files with others, but can't send it via e-mail because of the large file size, you can upload it to your ftp site which is part of your website. If you either don't know how to do this or it is not an available option, you may want to look into znail ([www.znail.com](http://www.znail.com)), an almost-free web resource for transferring large files.

After setting up an account, you simply upload the file you want to share via your web browser. Then you send your friend an e-mail with a special link to retrieve the file. If your file is under 5 MB, the service is free. For \$1, znail will increase your storage space to 20 MB, and if you spend \$10, you'll get 50 MB of space to use for an entire year.

There are a few drawbacks, but overall, this is an incredibly cheap and easy way to share large files with others.
